

Local attractions

Arnside is a large village with pretty shops and a delightful promenade situated on the Kent Estuary, with outstanding views over the Lakeland fells in a designated Area of Natural Outstanding Beauty.

Conveniently placed, just minutes from the M6, at No43 you are perfectly located to discover one of the most beautiful and hidden corners of England.

Whatever your interests from visiting stately homes to enjoying the superb walks along the coastal path and further inland enjoying delightful woodland trails along the limestone pavement enjoying the natural attractions waiting to be explored.

The RSPB looks after a number of sites including Leighton Moss nature reserve well known for its special birds, marsh harriers, bitterns and bearded tits. Natural England (formerly English nature) owns and manages Gait Barrow nature reserve 14 of the 50 Orchids grown in Britain inhabit the area including the rare Lady's Slipper orchid.

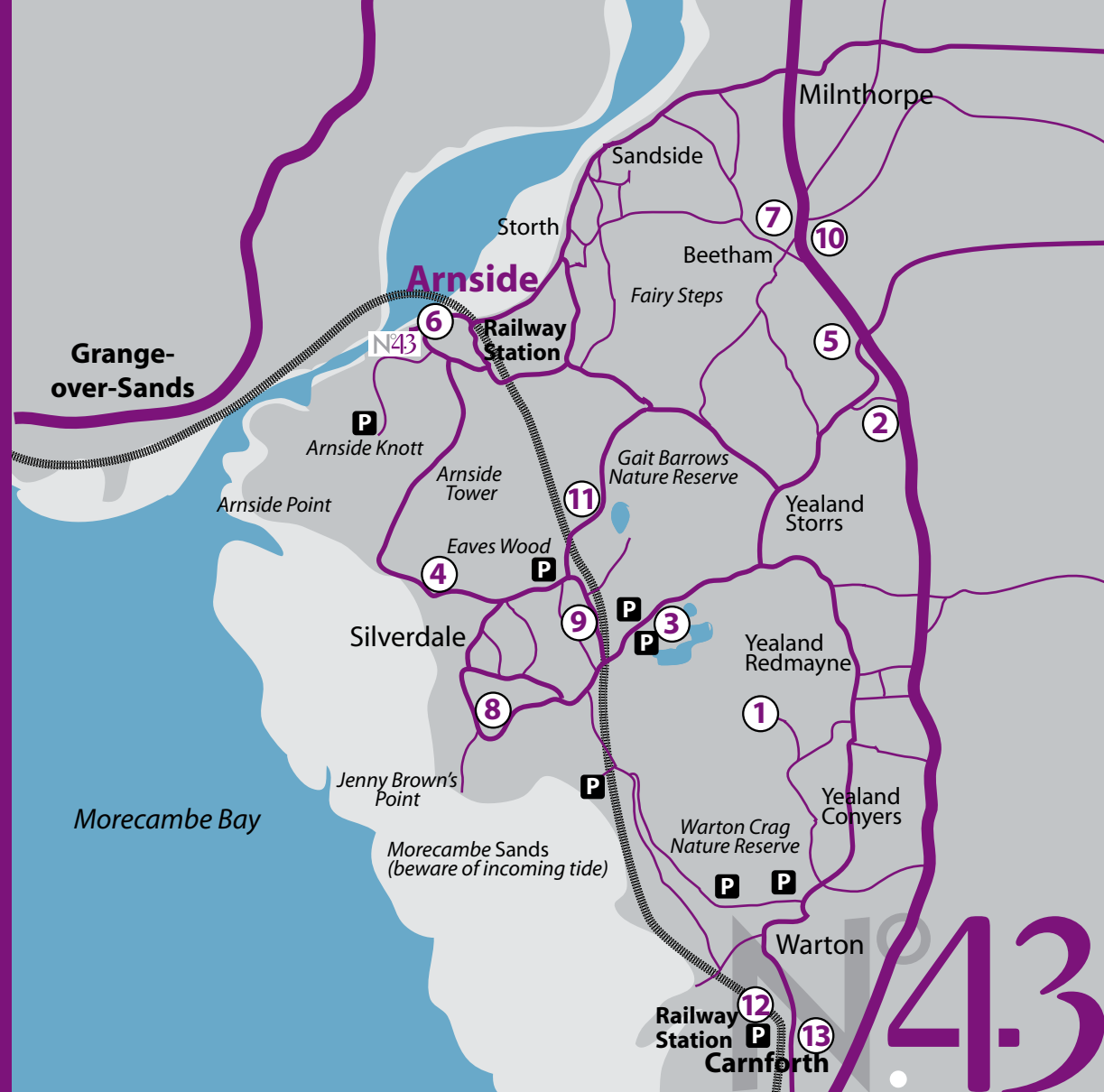
